APRIL

25 - 29	Change to summer uniform. World Book Week celebrated at school. Different year groups will carry out different activities. Also, two prominent personalities have been invited to read virtually to the students.
28	No school for all students. Teachers will attend the MRC Symposium organised by the College Principal.
29	Years 4, 5 and 6 – Talks for students by Richmond Foundation professionals re mental health techniques/skills for children.

MAY

2	Holiday instead of 1 st May. No school for all students.
4	Surprise and fun-filled event for all the school community. We will be celebrating the Feast of St. Bartolomeo, the patron saint of the village. Also, we will be giving the annual free ice-cream to the students together with free candy floss/popcorn. Students may come to school in casual clothes and wear a green/red t-shirt. Green and red are the colours of the Gharghur feast. Students may also wear green/red hair spray as if they were attending the village feast. €2.50 donation to the school to partly cover expenses for this event. Thanks to the Gharghur Local Council, the school street will be free from traffic between 9.30a.m and 12.30p.m. During this time, students will choose their own ice-cream from the ice-cream van parked in front of the school. The same goes for popcorn/candy floss. School starts and finishes as usual. Transport runs as usual.
